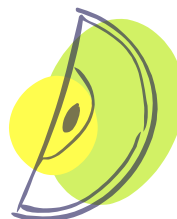

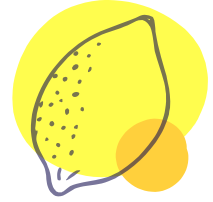

When and why do we use passive voice?



The passive voice is used to show interest in the person or object that experiences an action rather than the person or object that performs the action. In other words, the most important thing or person becomes the subject of the sentence.

Forming the passive voice



The passive voice in English is composed of two elements:

the appropriate form of the verb
'to be' + past participle



Passive Voice structure



Subject	+ to be (conjugated)	+ past participle	+ rest of a sentence
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× Simple present

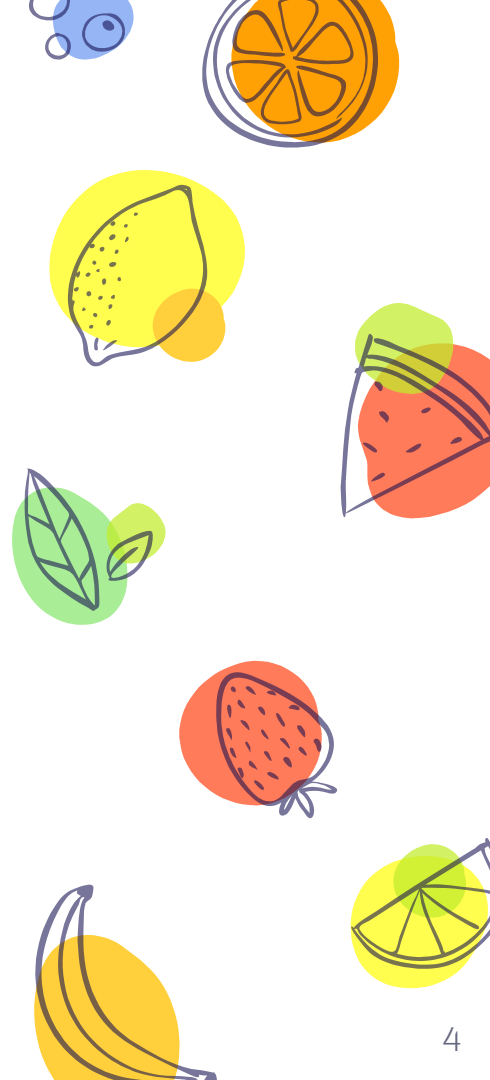
The house	is	Cleaned	Everyday.
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Present continuous

The house	Is being	cleaned	everyday
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Simple past

The house	was	cleaned	yesterday
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Past continuous

The house	Was being	cleaned	Last week
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Present perfect

The house	Has been	cleaned	Since you left
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Past perfect

The house	Had been	cleaned	Before they arrived
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Future

The house	Will be	Cleaned	Next week
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Future continuous

The house	Will be being	cleaned	tomorrow
